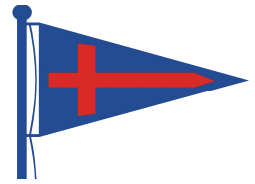

Requiescat In Pacem

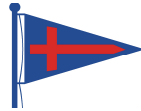
